Arthur Charles ("**Charlie**") Barber, 11 Jan 1899 – 16 Aug 1987, mayor of Lewes. Father Arthur Guy Barber.

Her brother Thomas Frank Richardson born 25 May 1904, died 14 Jul 1972, Brighton, and sister Phyllis Julia Goldsmith.
